Appointments

Our appointments are typically booked at 15 minute intervals, but longer appointments are available on request. If you have multiple issues to discuss or a potentially complex medical issue that takes more time to work through, you will be billed accordingly.

If family members need to be seen, please book an appointment for each family member; this allows us the appropriate time to provide the best care.

Billing

iSpot Clinic is a mixed billing clinic and gap fees generally apply. Fees can be settled by Cash, Credit Card or EFTPOS. In the event of financial hardship, please discuss this with your Doctor.

Cancelling Appointments

Please arrive in time for your appointment and check-in with reception. If you are unable to make your appointment or are delayed, please advise us so we are able to offer your time slot to another patient or re-arrange our appointments as needed.

If you book an appointment and do not attend we may charge a missed booking fee.

Prescriptions

We encourage patients to visit their doctor for repeat prescriptions, so medical care can be reviewed at the same time.



Bulk billed appointments for repeat prescriptions only are available, however a private fee apply if additional matters are attended to in the consultation.

Alternatively, you may request a repeat prescription without an appointment by filling in a request form at the clinic or at our website - a fee applies for these repeat prescriptions.

Our doctors will generally issue repeat prescriptions for long term medicines already prescribed by our clinic, but for certain medications such as potentially addictive medicines an appointment will be required.

Communication

If you need to contact a member of our clinical team but cannot attend, you may leave a message with our Reception Staff. Where possible non-urgent phone calls should be made after 10am to avoid peak time delays. Our clinical team will endeavour to return your call as soon as possible, but this will generally be after consultations have finished.

We use SMS appointment reminders for Registered Patients who have consented to this service. Emails to the clinic will be managed appropriately, but if we need to reply we may do so by phone.

Pathology Tests

There is a Pathology Collection Centre adjoined to the clinic at 6 Hazelwood Road offering blood tests and other investigations. They will process test requests for all doctors / clinics and send the results on the requesting doctor.

Test Results

We encourage patients to attend to discuss their results. Please do not assume that a test is normal if you have not been contacted by our staff.



Medical Examinations

Longer appointments are typically needed for Medical Examinations and Occupational Medicals, and we may also need to arrange for you to see the Nurse first. Please advise the receptionist when booking if you are attending for a specific Medical Examination.

Services

We offer a diverse range of health care, our services include:

- Medical Consultations and general health and well-being advice.
- Skin Cancer checks, diagnosis, preventive advice, skin lesion removals and management.
- Non-surgical skin cancer treatments (when appropriate).
- Surgical procedures for skin lesions, lacerations, lumps and bumps including skin cancers.
- Counselling and psychological support.
- Immunisations for children and adults.
- Travel advice – including travel immunisations. iSpot Clinic is registered for Yellow Fever Vaccinations. You don't have to be a regular patient of our clinic to access our Travel Advice & Vaccination Service.
- Women's Health Advice.
- PAP smear tests including a Nurse operated Pap test and Women's Clinic.
- Occupational health and pre-employment checks.
- Palliative care
- Home visits when medically appropriate - additional fees apply to this service.
- Health and well-being checks are encouraged. This can include blood pressure, cholesterol checks, weight management, immunisations, status, diabetes checks or optimisation, bowel cancer screening, breast checks / mammogram referrals, skin checks, prostate health.
- Total Body Photography / Mole Mapping.
- Registered Nurses are available to assist with asthma management, vaccinations and wound management.
